In Slovenia, a country of only two million people, Arnes managed to get over 4,500 people to participate in the country's **first massive open online course** on internet **safety** and **security** (MOOC-S).

65% of those who took part in the MOOC-S passed it successfully, gaining digital skills relating to internet security and the safe use of online technologies in the process.
